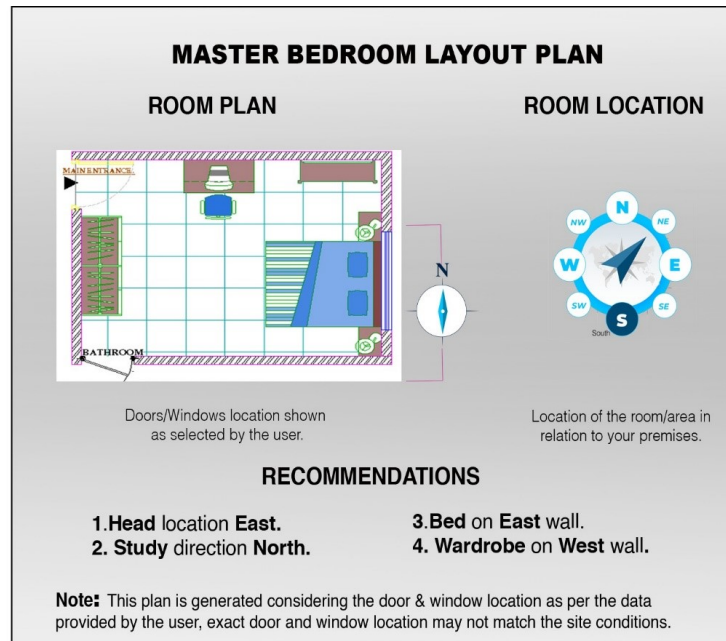

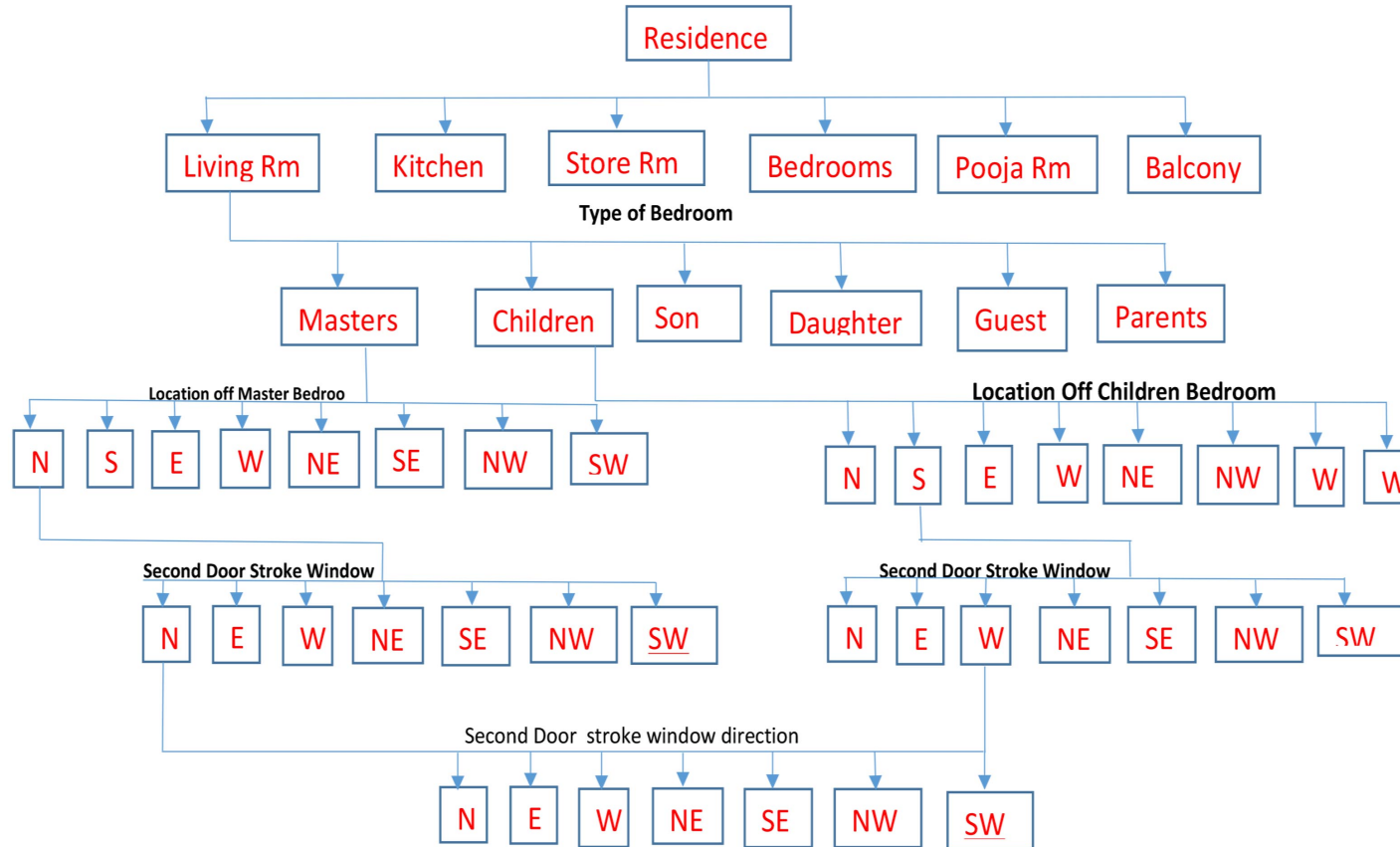

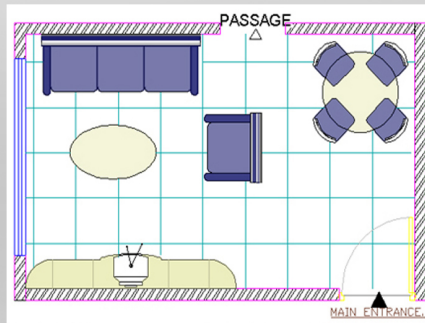

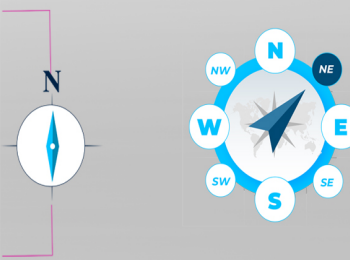

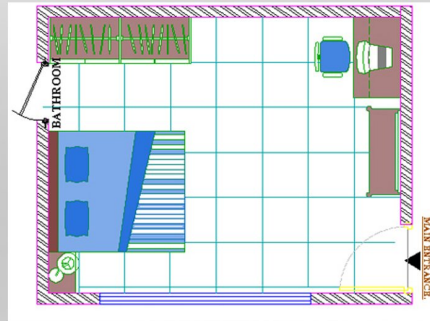

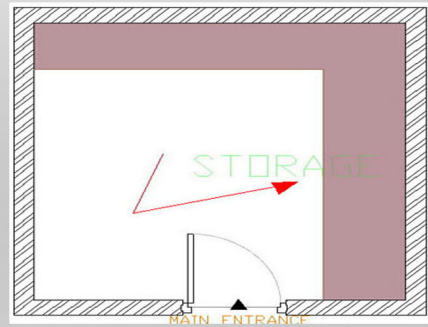

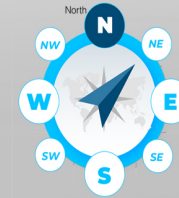

Because he/she spends maximum of time in the house approximately 9 to 12 hours and out of which about 7 to 8 hours in one static direction while sleeping. The food he eats is prepared in this house.



Master Bedroom

This is the most important room of the house as this is a place where one rest in single location and direction.

Utmost care should be taken while considering Vastu tenets for master bedroom as master should be healthy and commending in the house. Ideal location recommended is South zone for master bedroom.



Parents' Bedroom

Vastu recommendations are different for retired parents

As after certain age rest is more important than work, a bedroom located right side of South zone is recommended, and one has to be very careful in planning the interior placement of furniture in this room.



Guest Bedroom

Not so important room as per Vastu

This it can be located in any non-important corner of the house. Preferably North or West zone of the house.

Guest room can also double-up as audio video room or also as study room if it is located in North zone.

Son/Daughters Bedroom

This is one the most important room in the house.

The children should be in learning and development zone of the house. Learning and developing zone will make them good in studies, and if in business, a successful entrepreneur.





Toilets

Toilet are the least important rooms in the house as per Vastushastra.

When Vastu was written there was no proper sanitation systems hence in ancient times they were recommended away from livable areas, today we have excellent sanitary systems and above all modern materials like tiles, and sanitary fittings make toilets very hygienic and beautiful, so having them in the house is no problem.



Kitchen

Kitchen is the second most important room in the house after Bedrooms.

Good healthy food keep family member physically and mentally healthy, and healthy body and mind will always perform better in life.



Pooja/Study Room

Pooja/Study room is a place to Concentrate and Meditate.

Place to study or meditate should be located in North zone, as this zone is a powerful magnetic zone.

One should face powerful solar direction or magnetic direction.
